Class of 2024 GRADUATION Checklist: (diploma)

All of the following requirements must be met to be considered a potential graduate to earn your diploma:

- You must have earned a minimum of 26 credits by end of semester 1.
- You must be scheduled to take the remaining courses needed to complete the 18 compulsory credits and the 12 optional credits for a total of 30 credits by mid-term semester 2.
- You must have submitted documentation of 40 hours of community volunteer activities by April 15th, 2024.
- Diplomas for graduates will be available for pick up in the summer of 2024. Details to be posted online.
