#### Grade 9 Orientation Day

Please join us on **Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup>** for our Grade 9 Orientation Day. The day will start at 9am and will end at 2:30 pm. In the morning you will receive your timetable, go for a tour to find your classes, and meet senior mentors. Students will receive their laptop if they have completed the required forms that are available to parents/caregivers in the Parent Portal. Lunch will be provided (vegetarian and halal options will be available). It's a fantastic way to learn more about the transition to secondary school and meet some other new Storm. Since it is scheduled for 6 hours with various activities, students are encouraged to attend on their own. Please contact the school if your child has special needs requiring additional support on this day. You'll also get a chance to meet some of the staff who will be supporting you as you transition from Grade 8 to Grade 9, like the school Administration, Guidance Counsellors, Student Success teachers, Learning Resource teachers, and a variety of grade 9 teachers. No registration is required – just show up on the 27<sup>th</sup> at 9am! (unfortunately, school buses do not start until the first day of school so students will need to arrange their own transportation for this day).

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#### The First Few Days

Students return for the first day of the school year on **Tuesday, September 3**<sup>rd</sup>. Classes start at 8:00am. Please bring a combination lock with you on the first day of school so you can be assigned a locker by your period 1 teacher. Please also make note that picture day is on <u>September 17<sup>th</sup></u> (retakes are October 24<sup>th</sup>). You will have the opportunity to purchase photo packages online, but even if you do not want to purchase photos, it is still important to get your photo taken for your student card. Students can download a digital copy of their ID card which is provided free of charge to all students.

Timetables can be seen via the Parent Portal during the final week of August. Guidance counsellors will be back in the school <u>August 27<sup>th</sup></u> and <u>August 28<sup>th</sup></u>, by appointment, if any timetable changes are required. Timetable changes may be limited due to how full our classes are this year, but we always try to meet students' needs. Paper copies of timetables will also be available for pick up in the front foyer on September 3<sup>rd</sup> if you are unable to attend the Orientation Day on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

#### The Learning Environment & PPM 128

The environment in which we learn is very important to all of us at Saltfleet. It is crucial for all students to feel safe and welcome. If you come across any issues, please make sure a staff member is made aware so that we can support you. You can approach us in the halls or come down and see us in the main office. A Student Handbook containing information about the Code of Conduct will be posted on the Saltfleet website shortly. We encourage students and families to read this document together.

All students will have the use of a laptop or iPAD. Please ensure these devices are charged and brought to school daily as they may be used in the classroom for educational purposes, as directed by the teacher. This includes accessing educational resources, collaborating on assignments, and other activities that support learning objectives. In the spring, the Ministry of Education updated <u>PPM 128</u> which strengthens the Provincial

Code of Conduct's restrictions on the use of personal mobile devices in schools. These updates also prohibit possession and use of vaping, nicotine, cannabis and smoking products. It is important for all students and families to understand the expectations when it comes to cell





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phone use and vaping in any HWDSB secondary school. We will spend time at the beginning of the school year ensuring that all students and families receive this important information. However, the short version is that, first, students must have their personal mobile devices stored out of view and powered off (or on silent mode) during instructional time unless permitted by the educator for educational use. Students may use their phones during breaks and lunch. Second, there is no vaping or smoking on school property at all, under any circumstances. There will be consequences for students accessing their cell phones during instructional time and for students vaping at school, so we wanted to begin sharing this awareness information now. Additional information will be shared in the weeks ahead by HWDSB and by Saltfleet to support students and families in understanding and complying with this updated Provincial Code of Conduct.


#### Drop Off and Pick up
