GUIDING QUESTION FOR DISCUSSION:

In this inclusive model where all students attend their local school, what supports and strategies need to be considered in the school and community to address:

ACADEMIC NEEDS

- Better athletic facilities to support: both team and individual development, Eco course facilities (hiking, kayaking) and Navy Seals Fitness eg. Full gyms
- > Students need to be with their "like" groups as well as in a mixed environment

SAFETY FOR ALL STUDENTS

A cap on how big a school can become

SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL AND MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS

- Size may impact identification of mental health needs
- Sense of belonging/community eg. Making a school team
- More intramurals to make up for opportunity to be on school team
- Access to intramurals more facilities to support it
- Better playing fields space, safe (not full of potholes)
- Access to recreation facilities (eg. Aquatic Centre)

STUDENTS CHOOSING TO ATTEND PROGRAMS IN OTHER SCHOOLS

- Trade off cluster group vs school group (like group vs access)
- Transportation services shuttle buses, regular services
- Students need
- Can a program be declared "full" at a school? Is there a hierarchy?
