### **Reorganization at Shannen Koostachin**

As we continue to work together navigating the challenges we face as a school community, I wanted to provide a clear picture of what is happening at Shannen Koostachin for reorganization. As you all have read in the media, HWDSB is undertaking a massive reorganization process due to declining face to face enrollment. Effective November 3rd, Shannen Koostachin will be closing 3 classrooms and reorganizing students and teachers into classes to continue to support enhanced public health measures and reduced class size requirements. Many students will be impacted by this reorganization and may be moved into different classes and /or have a change in homeroom teacher starting November 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please be assured that we will work hard as a team to limit the impact on students as much as possible at this time. On Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup> all students that are impacted by the change will receive an individual letter. This letter will indicate your child's new class placement or new teacher. We are unable to take any requests or make any changes to this placement. Please know that the staff at Shannen Koostachin will continue to support all of the needs of our students during this time of change.

## **DAILY SELF SCREENING PROCESS**

Please ensure that you are reviewing the self screening checklist daily with your child. A revised screening tool has been issued by the Ministry. If children come down with COVID related symptoms during school, we must follow Public Health protocols. The first step to this process is that parents pick up immediately. If a student has a symptom that is normal for them related to a known cause or condition, parents, guardian/caregivers are encouraged to provide this information as early as possible, before symptoms display themselves. Please take a reasonable approach to these situations considering your child's history and symptoms presenting themselves.

# **RETURN TO SCHOOL ATTESTATION FORM**

If a student fails the screening for any of the above reasons and is absent from school, the student requires a completed "Attestation for return to school following illness or self isolation." If a student is sent home from school, we will provide a hard copy of this form to families to complete upon return of the student. If a student fails the screening while at home, please contact the school when the student is ready to return to school and we will help you with this attestation process.

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

If there is inclement weather in the morning, staff will invite students to come directly into the building. Students will report to their classrooms. Given how important outdoor time is for students, especially





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right now to provide mask breaks, please continue to have students dress appropriately for the weather as we will prioritize outdoor learning. If we are unable to get out for our normal nutritional breaks due to inclement weather of field condition, staff will continue to use time during the day for outdoor mask breaks by taking students for walks and physical activity.

#### **PICTURE DAY**

Due to COVID restrictions, picture day will be postponed for the time being. We are working with HWDSB and Edge Imaging to schedule this as soon as it is possible while still maintaining our enhanced public health measures.

### **HALLOWEEN**

We know that Halloween is a time that many students look forward to, and we want to be able to provide our students with some fun activities this year as well. Here are the guidelines that have been provided to schools for Halloween Celebrations on **Friday, October 30**<sup>th</sup> in classrooms:

- Students can chose to dress in <u>orange and black</u> or a <u>costume</u> for the day
- No weapons with costumes are permitted at school
- No costume masks that might impede vision are permitted
- All students must continue to wear their non- medical masks at school
- If wearing a costume, students must come to school already dressed
- Costumes must be comfortable and promote independence, staff will not be able to support changing throughout the day
- No costume parades are permitted
- No in-person assemblies are permitted
- No sharing/distributing food or drink is permitted- see letters from your classroom teacher for specifics for your child's classroom
- Maintain safe practices including physical distancing and hand hygiene.

#### **OCTOBER CHARACTER TRAIT**

This year we will continue our school's tradition of celebrating character traits along with the *Seven Grandfather Teachings* of Love, Respect, Bravery, Truth, Honesty, Humility, and Wisdom. The character trait for the month of November will be COURAGE. We will continue to celebrate with our staff and students with monthly virtual assembles. On October 30, our school will be celebrating our October character trait of HONESTY.





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#### **REPORTS SENT HOME**

Shannen Koostachin students have been working hard during their first six weeks of school, and we are proud of the learning that they have done. Students will be bringing home their progress reports on October 29th. Please read your child's report and sign and return the envelope and last section of the progress report to your child's homeroom teacher. Due to COVID restrictions, we will not be providing opportunities for face to face parent teacher conferences, rather would ask that you connect with your child's teacher for a phone call or virtual meeting. More information will be coming regarding this opportunity on November 27<sup>th</sup>.
