READINESS FOR DISTANCE LEARNING

At the request of the Ministry of Education, HWDSB is asking elementary families whose students are currently learning in-person to assess their preparedness to have students learn from home. The Readiness for Distance Learning Survey was first launched on Friday, November 6 and the deadline has been **extended to Friday, November 20, 2020 at 11:59 PM.** Please visit **FORMS** in the parent portal and look for the Readiness for Distance Learning Survey. Please complete one per child in your household.

FORMS ON THE PARENT PORTAL

A reminder to stay up to date in your completion of required forms on the parent portal. The most current form available to families is the 'Student Verification Form'. This is an important form to complete as it will help us keep our records up to date including any changes that you have had in address, phone numbers and emergency contacts. Thank you for staying up to date with the forms in the parent portal.

PARENT/GUARDIAN ACCESS TO THE SCHOOL

This year, schools have been asked by the Ministry of Education to significantly limit or even prohibit visitors to the school, including parents. It is strongly recommended that parents do not drop off items during the school day unless the items are essential. If you are picking up your child from the school early for an appointment, please use the door buzzer and the office staff will support you with this process. A reminder that all parents/guardians must wear a mask when on the school grounds.

We have had a number of parent concerns regarding student safety around our school. In particular, there have been reports that students and parents are running between parked cars on Bellagio Avenue and Keystone Crescent and crossing the road in front of moving vehicles. SECURE SCHOOLS SAFETY PROCEDURES

Based on HWDSB policies and procedures, at Shannen Koostachin we have outlined procedures for conducting emergency drills to keep our students and staff safe in the event of an emergency. Part of our yearly planning and practice includes fire drills as well as safe schools drills including lockdown, hold and secure, shelter in place and bomb threat drills. While we have completed 3 fire drills to date, in the coming months we will also begin to practice our safe school drills. It is important to note that our emergency drills this school year will continue to align with current public health advice and measures. DAILY SELF SCREENING PROCESS

Please ensure that you are reviewing the self screening checklist daily with your child(ren) each morning before school. If you child fails the screener, please keep your child home from school and report the absence to the school office. If your child develops COVID related symptoms during school, we must follow Public Health protocols to support the safety of all students and staff. The first step to this process is for parents to pick up immediately. We recognize that this may be challenging for some parents, but we are required to adhere to Public Health protocols.

RETURN TO SCHOOL ATTESTATION FORM

If a student fails the screening for any of the above reasons and is absent from school, the student requires a completed Attestation for Return to School Following Illness or Self Isolation form. If a student is sent home from school, we will provide a hard copy of this form to families to complete upon return of the student. If a student fails the screening while at home, please contact the school when the student is ready to return to school and we will help you with this attestation process.

PD DAY NOVEMBER 27- NO SCHOOL

Friday, November 27, 2020 is designated as a Professional Activity Day for all HWDSB schools. All staff will participate in a half day of mandatory violence prevention training. Elementary schools will use the remaining half day for communication with parents/guardians/caregivers regarding student progress. There is no school for students on this day.
