Nature Letters

Using objects you find outside (sticks, rocks, leaves, flowers) make the letters of the alphabet.

Challenge - Leave a kind message for someone to find.

You've Got Mail

Draw a picture and/or write a letter to a friend, family member or someone in your community. Drop it off, send an email or put it in the mail.

What's Missing?

Draw a letter in the dirt, sand or on paper. Ask your child to find an object beginning with that letter. Draw a different letter and have them find an object beginning with the new letter. Do this several times, then have your child look at the objects they collected. Ask them to look away while you remove one object. Can they guess which object was removed? Challenge - Put the objects in alphabetical order.
