

Safety is our number one priority. At Shannen Koostachin we have many safety procedures in place to ensure your child(ren)'s safety.

Attendance is taken twice a day, once in the morning and again after second break. It is crucial that this is completed in a timely, accurate fashion.

To ensure accuracy and safety, absences *must* be reported to the School Messenger App before school.

These reported absences ensure that all students are accounted for and safe.

## SCHOOL DROP OFF AND PICK UP

#### <u>KINDERGARTEN</u>

In order to support the safe drop off of kindergarten students we are asking that all parents and caregivers drop their child (ren) off in the appropriate Kindergarten fenced in areas at the beginning of the day between 9:15–9:30 am. There will be a teacher on duty in the gated area ready to accept your student. Once they are in the fenced in area they will remain there until the bell rings at which time the teacher will lead them into the school. We ask that parents do not enter the fenced in area or school at this time. This is also where your child (ren) will be handed off to you at the end of the day. Thank you for supporting us in keeping all students safe.

#### GRADES 1-8

Duty Supervisors are out on the back playground between 9:15–9:30 am. With keeping student safety as our #1 priority we would like to ask that parents work together with us to please remain off of the back field at this time. Thank you for supporting us in keeping all students safe.

# LATE ARRIVALS -

### SCHOOL BEGINS AT 9:30 am

If your child is late for school, please bring your child to the main office and they will be supported in getting to their classroom. If you know your child will be late or absent for the day please ensure that you put this into School Messenger that can be found on the board website or the App can be downloaded to your phone. Otherwise your child will be marked as Unexplained, documenting that calls home were unsuccessful.

## **EARLY PICK UPS -**SCHOOL ENDS AT 3:50 pm

It is extremely important that students stay in school for the daily duration, as interruptions to class not only affect the learning of your student, but also interrupts the whole class, as well as the Office and Admin. The Final bell goes at 3:50 pm. and it is expected that students remain at school until that time- with students and parents both knowing the after school routine (pick up or bus etc.). However, if you do need to pick up your child from school early, we remind you to please allow some extra time for your child to arrive at the office. Students will be called down once you are here and it can take a few minutes for your child(ren) to gather there things and get to the office area. Please let your child(ren)s classroom teacher know if you will picking up early and the time so they can ensure that your child is ready.



# PARKING LOT

A reminder that our school parking lot is for staff only and the driveway will be closed off for traffic during school drop off and pick up to ensure all of our safety and access for our buses. Street parking is available at the front and to the side of our building, please note that this can get very busy at drop off and pick up and we encourage all those students

who are able to walk, bike/scooter etc. to do so. This will ease the congestion of the traffic in our area and keep everyone safe.

At Shannen Koostachin we are on a balanced day schedule. Our First Nutrition Break is from 11:10-11:50 am, and Second Nutrition Break is from 1:30-2:10 pm At this time students will alternate going outside for 20 minutes and reporting to their lunch room to have their morning snack/ afternoon lunch.

Should you need to drop off lunch at the school we have a table in the front foyer with labels and pens so you can label your child's lunch with their full name and teacher name. Please ensure your child knows you are dropping lunch so they can come down at break to collect it.

Please try to supply your child with the appropriate outdoor clothing/shoes/coats/boots by the time they arrive to school.

Any Grade 7 and 8 students wanting to leave the school property for lunch will need to have authorization completed first, by parent, on the parent portal prior to leaving the school.

Grade 7-8 students leaving property to go out for lunch are permitted to do so on <u>SECOND BREAK ONLY. (PLEASE NOTE-</u> THIS LUNCH OPTION HAS

NOT BEGUN YET)



# PRAYER ROOM

For parents that take their children out of school to pray or for parents who wish to have their child pray at school, we at Shannen Koostachin school have a quiet room set aside to accommodate any students wishing to pray. The prayer time is available during their nutrition break at 1:30pm in room 114. All those wishing to pray are welcome. A teacher will be present to supervise but will not lead a prayer. Students can pray on their own or with a friend. If you have any questions, please contact the school.





We want all children and staff, including those with a life-threatening allergy, to feel safe, supported, and accepted at school. Please be aware that there are several students at Shannen Koostachin school who have a severe life-threatening food allergy to any food containing: **ALL nuts, including peanuts, tree nuts, cashews, pistachios; legumes, including lentils, chickpeas, and pea protein; dairy, egg, soy, sesame seeds, shellfish (shrimp), coconut & celery.** 

These are life-threatening allergies that are likely to result in anaphylaxis, a sudden and severe allergic reaction that can be fatal.

We can all help foster a safe and inclusive environment by preventing such a dangerous and frightening situation at our school. The students and their families are taking responsibility to avoid exposure to **ALL nuts including peanuts, tree nuts, cashews, pistachios; legumes including lentils, chickpeas and pea protein; dairy, egg, soy, sesame seeds, shellfish (shrimp), coconut & celery.** All staff have been instructed on the correct procedures regarding anaphylactic shock if an exposure occurs.

To help reduce risk, please help your child(ren) understand the seriousness of this allergy and encourage empathy for the child. Some children need reminders on why we do not share food with others. Please make every effort to avoid sending lunches or snacks containing **ALL nuts including peanuts**, tree nuts, cashews, pistachios; legumes including lentils, chickpeas and pea protein; dairy, egg, soy, sesame seeds, shellfish (shrimp), coconut & celery. In addition, please do not send food for special events such as cupcakes to celebrate your child's birthday, a small non-perishable item is preferred if you wish the students to celebrate along with your child.

### SAFE WELCOME SCHOOLS



As you may know, HWDSB initiated a Safe Welcome Program in 2013. The program supports a welcoming learning environment by ensuring that parents and other authorized visitors can access elementary schools while keeping students and staff safe.

Based on the HWDSB safe welcome program, exterior school doors must remain locked during the instructional day, and visitors access the school during school hours via the main entrance. You will notice that our main entrance is equipped with a video/intercom access system and signage. The access system allows staff to see and talk with any visitors requesting entry into the school. The system also allows school office staff to electronically release the lock on the door. Please note that we will continue to ask visitors to report to the office for sign-in. Principals maintain ultimate authority for visitors admitted into their school. If you have any questions about the program or the system, please contact the office.
