SHERWOOD APPEARANCE CODE

Students should be neat and clean in their appearance and in their habits. The key words concerning appearance are that students should dress “in good taste” and in a manner appropriate to a learning and working environment.

Unacceptable clothing at school includes, but is not limited to:

- bare feet;
- bare midriffs;
- cut-off shorts;
- tank/tube tops;
- muscle shirts/undershirts;
- mini-skirts;
- and clothing which reveals undergarments.

Pants must be pulled up and worn so that the waist is covered and clothing beneath the pants is not visible.

Students shall not wear:

- clothing with suggestive/objectionable printing or visuals;
- clothing which reveals undergarments, advertises violence, alcohol, drugs, sex, tobacco;
- or clothing that makes political statements while they are on school property or while participating in school events.

Bandanas, accessories with spikes, chains of excessive length and thickness (i.e. chains that have alternate uses and that are

not specifically intended to be jewellery), and the wearing of sunglasses are not permitted in school.

Coats and large bags should be stored in lockers.

Certain subject areas may have additional appearance and clothing requirements which must be followed for safety reasons.

Staff will send students who refuse to conform to the appearance code to the Main Office.
