| Tuition and fees             | Check the program you're interested in for an estimated cost                                                                                        | \$   |
| Books and equipment          | Books, kits and supplies typically add up to around \$1,000                                                                                         | \$   |
| Rent or residence            | Rent can range from \$400-\$700+/month. Each semester is 4 months                                                                                   | \$   |





### → Update Financial Assistance


- Any significant changes to your OSAP application <u>must be</u> adjusted by Financial Assistance.







Ontario Ontario Student Assistance Program Your OSAP funding will be deposited into your bank account after your enrollment is confirmed by the Financial Assistance Office at your school. For most students, this step will take place at the beginning of your first semester then half way again through your study period (start of semester 2).

Students will receive 60% of their OSAP funding in semester 1, and the remaining 40% in semester 2.

# OSAP Repayment - How to repay your student debt

For the first 6 months after you graduate, finish your studies, or stop being a full-time college or university student:

- you don't need to make any loan payments
- no interest is charged on the Ontario portion of your student loan
- interest is charged on the Canada portion of your student loan

This is called your 6 month grace period.

You start to repay your loan at the end of the 7th month after you leave school.


