About the Opportunity:

Hamilton & District Extend-A-Family is looking for mature and motivated high school students who have an interest in working with youth with developmental delays. Starting in November, we will be running an after school “Homework Club” on Wednesday evenings for youth between the ages of 12 – 17 years old. The club will assist with homework, as well as provide an opportunity to socialize and play games with our staff and volunteers. The “Homework Club” will run for 6 weeks at a time, with a total of four (4) sessions over the course of the school year. The Club is supervised by the Recreation Coordinator, and dinner is provided to all participants.

Requirements:

- Currently enrolled in high school, grades 10 – 12
- Mature, reliable, interested in working with youth with developmental delays
- Fun, outgoing, and positive attitude
- Provide own transportation to our office
- Commit to minimum of 6 weeks
- Police check if over the age of 16
- 3 references
- No previous experience required

Responsibilities:

- Assist with homework for youth with developmental delays ages 12 – 17
- Play games and socialize with participants
- Minimum 6 week time commitment
