

Requirements

- 10 total credits
- 4 French immersion courses (1 per grade)
- It is recommended that you take 4 courses in grade 9 and 4 courses in grade 10

All pathways are great options for students. When determining what course type to take in grade 9, we advise following the recommendation from your grade 8 teachers. The goal for grade 9 is to earn all 8 credits and to transition to high school successfully both emotionally and academically. Students may mix courses from all course types. The end pathway, whether work, college, apprenticeship or university can be reached in many different ways—it does not need to be decided in grade 9.

When can I complete them?


- Starting on July 1st the summer before grade 9


