

• Be better supported in achieving their academic goals This looks like: Getting one on one support from the grad coach or getting linked to a Black mentor. In the future we can also get you connected with Scholarships for Black Students.

• Connect with community and school resources This looks like: Getting to know about the different community spaces created for Black students – You can even help out and get your 40 community service hours with them! If you need any extra supplies, you can always check in with the grad coach to see what's available.
