The Transition Advisory Committee will review and advise on:

- Culture and Traditions
- Transition Activities
- Traffic and transportation issues related to the temporary or permanent site
- Accommodation and program issues (providing any recommendations do not exceed the overall funding available to the school or contravene City, Board and/or Ministry requirements)
- Seeking feedback from public on transition work.

March 28, 2022

That a Transition Committee be struck as soon as possible (and no later than May 2022) and that it be inclusive of, but not limited to, Sherwood students, parents/guardians, and staff, who will support the transition of students between sites throughout the duration of the Sherwood renovation project, through:

- a) Regular updates (no less than bi-monthly)
- b) Be advised of any material status changes and impacts, anything that will change timelines and scope;
- c) Committee members provide feedback on the transition planning, transportation/safe routes to school, school traditions and celebration dates, opportunities to tour sites and communications to the wider school community
- d) Be kept informed on how Sherwood students are being engaged and how student voice is being gathered about the Sherwood renovation project and transition planning

March 28, 2022

That the Sherwood student body be engaged and student voice be gathered with regards to the Sherwood renovation project and transition planning, such as, but not limited, visual aspects of the renovation project plans, colours/branding; school traditions and celebration dates; opportunities to tour sites with enhanced consideration for tour/transition planning for students with special needs.



- Roofing replacement challenges: 25% of decking had to be replaced (original scope was just outer membrane replacement)
- Weather challenges
- Locker repair and painting started
- Classroom painting on basement level
- 1st floor sprinkler mains

Spending:

- April \$2.2 million
- Avg \$1 million/ month (typical new builds \$500 000)

Guiding Principles:

- Goal is to complete work on the quickest timelines possible
- Requires the ability to have necessary permits and occupancy
- Meet all Health & Safety requirements
- Ability to have the school have a full academic program
- June 9th (week of) – Confirmation of timeline communication (School Messenger)

- Currently on time for winter break move
- Progress is being constantly reviewed
- Any timeline change would be communicated to committee by early October

Week of June 9th

- Public communication
- Confirming September start at temporary site
- Progress update in October
- Current timeline is a winter break move
