









- Educators communicate with parents in many ways








# Your child's day

- Before and after-school programs (childcare)








# **Transportation**

- This year, we are consolidating the Elizabeth Bagshaw and Sir Wilfrid Laurier Catchment areas








# Walking Map

- Anyone living outside of the pink area may be eligible for service








### **Transportation**

- Indoor Shoes, to remain at school






