### **1. Human Growth & Development & Sexual Health**

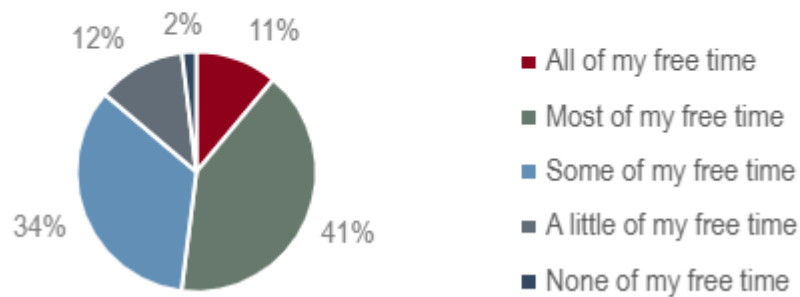
- Exemption Forms were release end of February and school received by March 18

### **2. Health & Peer Relations Survey**

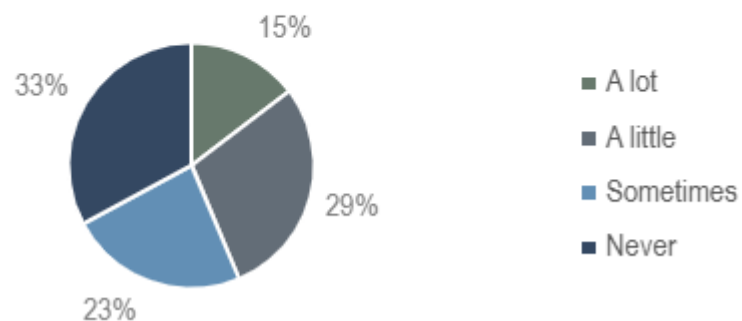
- Survey for students Grade 4-8 will be administered

### 3. Health & Peer Relations Survey Results Spring 2024 (some examples)

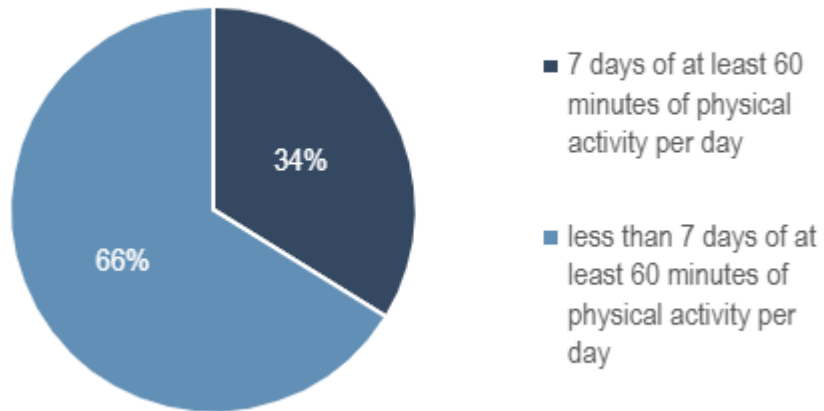
On a typical day, how much time do you spend using an electronic device such as a mobile device, computer, tablet, video game console or television while you are sitting or lying down ?



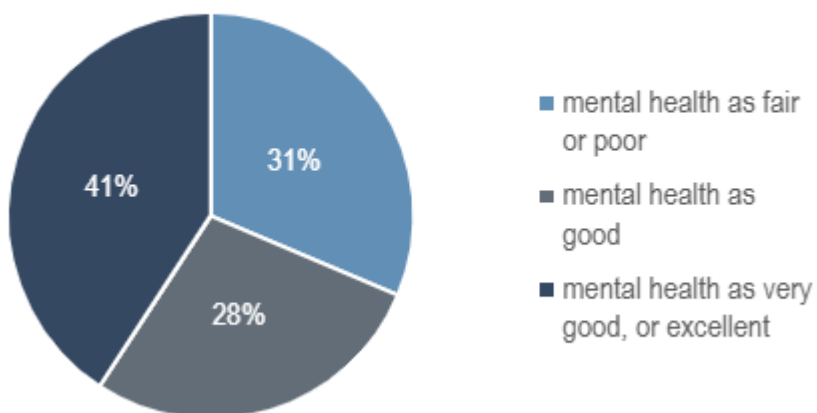
How often do you use your mobile phone for no particular reason at school?



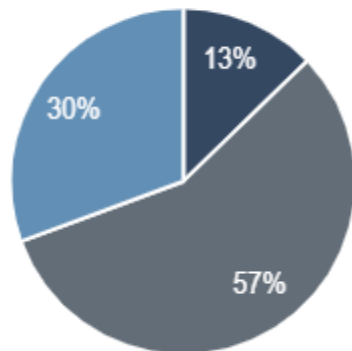

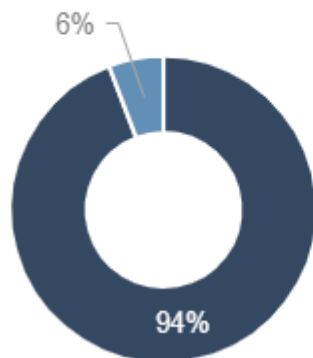
## Stress
