
1. Human Growth & Development & Sexual Health


- Exemption Forms were release end of February and school received by March 18

- Instruction will begin end of March until end of April


2. Health & Peer Relations Survey


- Survey for students Grade 4-8 will be administered

- Survey reviews areas of student well-being, feelings of belonging, health, nutrition, attendance


