National Indigenous History Month

At HWDSB we continue our collective work to revivify, reclaim, renew, restore & celebrate Indigenous ways of knowing.

Pride Month

Pride Month is an annual event typically celebrated in June around the world. Over the course of the month, we at HWDSB strive to recognize and celebrate Two Spirit and LGBTQIA+ contributions, identities, and the allies who stand in solidarity and support. It is also a time of action; a time to raise awareness and develop actionable items relating to the rise in discrimination, hate, and violence toward Two Spirit and LGBTQIA+ people and communities, both locally and abroad.

Filipino Heritage Month

The Legislative Assembly of Ontario declared June as Filipino Heritage Month in 2021. The Filipino community is one of the largest and fastest growing diasporas in Canada. Canada and Ontario recognize the positive contributions, both past and present, made by the Filipino community. June represents a culturally significant time in Filipino history, as June 12th represents Filipino independence and separation from Spanish rule.

Italian Heritage Month

The month of June was proclaimed as Italian Heritage Month in Ontario in 2010. More than 1,500,000 Italian Canadians call Ontario home, and the province recognizes their economic, political, social and cultural contributions and achievements.
