We are pleased to announce that the Grades 7 & 8 trip to Camp Couchiching (north of Orillia) will take place from Wednesday, June 12 – Friday, June 14, 2019. Students choosing not to participate in this trip will be offered alternate programming at school.

For more information on this wonderful opportunity, we invite parents and guardians to an information session with the camp staff on Wednesday, March 27, 2019, in the school Learning Commons, from 6:00pm – 7:00pm. You will be able to pick up the permission forms and information packages at this meeting. Please come prepared with any questions you may have. If you are unable to attend but are still interested, Sir William Osler staff will be happy to answer any questions and provide a package at another time.

Students wishing to attend camp are asked to turn in their forms to Mme. O'Neil and payment to SCHOOL CASH ONLINE by April 30. Spaces are limited and if there is more demand than available accommodations, there will be a wait list created; *first come, first serve*. Students will also be required to successfully complete two swim tests to participate in the water activities. These activities are a main component of the programming at camp.

The cost of this trip is \$230 per student. Full payment is available for purchase on School Cash Online and will be available from Wednesday, March 27 to Tuesday, April 30. *please do not send cash or write a cheque*****
