Spaces are limited therefore spaces are available on a first come first serve basis until all spaces are spoken for at which point a waiting list will be in effect. Students will also be required to successfully complete two swim tests to participate in the water activities at camp. Further swim test information will be available the first week of may. These water activities are a significant portion of camp activities. Please note: the camp itinerary is attached. There will be no unsupervised time and night security will be provided.

Students choosing not to participate in this trip will be offered alternate programming at school. Our staff has worked hard to plan and organize this trip. SWO teachers all believe that our students are second to none and deserve this learning opportunity.
