- These must only be purchased and individually packaged treats (no home baked foods).

Keep in mind:

• The Truth and Reconciliation commitments

Avoid

- Hurtful or demeaning representations of cultural and/or creed beliefs in symbols, images/graphics/caricatures, texts.
- Images/graphics/caricatures of social identities that stereotype and promote prejudice and racism
- Costumes that stigmatize abilities, mental health, and wellbeing experiences
- Mischaracterizing and/or stereotyping gender identity and expression at any time of the school year including Hallowe'en Costumes that promote violence (real or fictitious) towards marginalized groups (including but not limited to misogyny, homophobia, Islamophobia, anti-Black racism)
- Pandemic-themed costumes that may cause distress for those impacted by the Covid-19 virus
- Costume dress that includes such paraphernalia as swords, shields, batons that potentially can be used as a weapon to ensure student safety. **These are not to be brought to school**.

Curriculum activities will be planned inclusively with options to meet the varying levels of student participation in Hallowe'en and other festive celebrations related to the harvest season.
