Meeting started at 18:05.

Present were seven parents and Principal Qureshi

Principal's report:

There was a discussion on Pizza Day and the role of Council members. Sasha had requested more clarity on the issue. The Principal, Mr. Qureshi said that:

- a) He would connect Sasha with Jen from school to discuss the details.
- b) There are 3 volunteers needed in the room every time there is food that needs to be distributed. There is 1 backup person, who is arranged by the lead.

Now that the Subway option has been added by the school, Mr. Qureshi said, there might be a requirement for more volunteers - the school will get a better idea this month, once these are rolled out.

One parent said that the Sub option was not communicated to the parents at the same time as the pizza option — which was a problem for parents since many of them would have opted for Subs over pizza. She suggested that the next time the school should communicate the options at the same time. Mr. Qureshi made note of this and said that the school would take care of it the next time.
