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Questions for Administration

November 23, 2023, School Council Meeting

1. What is the status of the end of year trip for the Grade 7 and 8 students? If the trip is not planned to occur, what can be done to ensure that our kids have the opportunity to experience this truly important and fulfilling trip?

Teachers participating in the 2022 camping trip encountered issues that have led to significant reluctance in being chaperones in any future "year-end" trips.

2. What resources and supports are available for sexual and gender diverse communities within the school?

SWO staff indicated that there are broad resources and that staff have multiple approaches to provide students many avenues to engage these resources

Secretary notes: Nothing specifically was brought forward but perhaps some sort of communication can go out reminding parents of how SWO has approaches to non-academic resources in lieu of being specific .

3. What is the number of students who live in lower-income households?
