Hello Osler Families,

Welcome Back Sir William Osler Families! As the 2025-26 school year quickly approaches, we are excited to welcome students back to class on Tuesday, September 2nd, 2025.

Bell Times are 9:15 AM-3:35 PM

Nutrition Breaks are 10:55 AM -11:35 AM and 1:15 PM -1:55 PM, 20 minutes inside/20 minutes outside

Beginning the new school year can be a time of excitement, nervousness and energy for students, staff and families alike.

But the start of the school year at Sir William Osler is also a time of new beginnings filled with opportunities for all students to experience a sense of belonging, engage in dynamic learning and reach their full potential.

To help Sir William Osler families prepare for their child(ren)'s return to the classroom, we would like to share the following information:

First Day: Students in Grades 1-8 will enter the school yard/pavement area at the back of the school and back field, where they will be greeted by their homeroom or period one teacher prior to the 9:15am bell. Parents are welcome to accompany their child(ren) on the first day of school. However, after September 2nd parents are asked to not wait on the playground with their child during the morning drop off.

- Each teacher will be holding a sign with their class grade and name on it for students to find. There will be staff circulating with class lists to further support and clarify student placements.
- Students will enter and exit the building via their designated entrance/exit doors (staff will communicate with students on the first day of school.)
- Junior Kindergarten (JK) and new Senior Kindergarten (SK) students have their pre-arranged visits with their teacher on *Tuesday September 2nd*, ready to start full day on *Wednesday September* 3rd.
- Senior Kindergarten (SK) students who previously attended Sir William Osler will begin on Wednesday, September 3rd. They will be dropped off at the K fenced area. Staff will be at the gate to welcome students and parents. ECE and EA staff will escort students directly into their classrooms upon arrival.

Staff Supervision: Each morning, students will be supervised by staff, wearing orange safety vests, on supervision duty on the back field, paved playground, and K entry areas starting at 9 am. Staff will also be supervising and supporting student dismissal at the front/back/playground/field at 3:35pm until 3:50pm. Students Gr.1-3 (unless on buses) can be met by parents on the back playground when the dismissal bell

rings. Parents will be able to enter and wait on the playground just before the dismissal bell. If you are meeting your child, designate a spot to meet on the playground so they know where to find you. It can get busy for a few minutes when everyone is leaving! Students meeting parents at the end of the day, are asked to clear the back playground/field area by 3:50 pm to make space for the YMCA's after school program.

<u>Parking Lots</u>: Families will be expected to park/drop-off/pick-up children in the **lower lot only.** *Please do NOT park or drive into the upper lot. This is only for busses, daycare agreements, and disability permits. We do not want to have students entering the lot simply because they see their family vehicle there. *It is a serious safety concern*.

<u>Transportation</u>: School buses will continue to unload and load in the same area as in previous years (upper parking lot bus lane). Hamilton Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) provides students with safe and secure transportation for eligible students by HWSTS. This may take the form of traditional school buses, school purpose vans or Hamilton Street Railway transit. For more information, visit HWDSB's <u>Transportation webpage</u>. If your child qualifies for transportation, please remember to re-check information prior to sending your child(ren) to their assigned pickup location on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, as changes can occur.

*Courtesy seating requests will be considered in the month of October. Please visit https://www.hamiltonschoolbus.ca/service.aspx and complete the courtesy busing form and provide same to the office.

<u>Dogs on Property</u>: Please do NOT bring family dogs onto school property during school hours including arrival and dismissal. There are bylaws to keep all staff, students, community members safe while on school property. As much as we all love our furry companions, we do not want to have any animal-related mishaps and/or negative experiences for anyone. If you have a certified service dog please contact administration.
