Teachers are beginning to prepare term one report cards. With all the stops and starts this year, we are sensitive to the impact of these challenges on students this school year. Report cards will continue to focus on the learning that students have been able to demonstrate. The report cards will come home with students on February 18<sup>th</sup>.

## A reminder:

COVID Protocols remain in effect at all HWDSB schools. These safety measures help everyone in our community (including those at home) remain safe. Here is a summary of the safety measures at South Meadow;

- Daily Screening Compete the daily screener to determine if you are safe to come to school and sign off on the verification calendar everyday
- Masks Students and staff need to wear a mask when inside the building and outdoors when physical distancing can not be maintained. Neck gaiters are not allowed by the HWDSB as a replacement for a mask.
- When at school, students learn and remain in their cohort/class for the instructional day. At nutrition breaks, students have designated areas to move and play in. Please remind your student that they must stay in their cohort area during nutrition break.
- Staff and students are asked to physically distance (2metres) themselves as best they can when interacting in classrooms and hallways.
- Each classroom is provisioned with hand sanitizer. Students are asked to sanitize their hands when entering their learning spaces.

With the snow and cold weather here, we wish to remind caregivers that students need to come to school with coats, hats, mittens and boots. Please remind your children that snow is to remain on the ground and not be thrown at others. Unfortunately, excess snow was piled onto our back playground and students are not to be climbing up the hill of snow.

## Entry & Dismissal:


Cones will be placed at the front entrance to prevent cars from entering between 8:05 and 8:35pm and again at dismissal from 2:35-2:55pm. This is for safety reasons.

The bus loading zone is marked with a sign. Please don't park in the bus loading zone or across from the loading zone (there is a fire hydrant there anyways and it shouldn't be blocked). Parking across from the bus loading zone is impeding traffic and making it difficult for buses to pull in and out of that area. Student safety is our paramount concern, your co-operation is needed.

Please consider walking or biking to school if you live close by. This is fun to do and great exercise – a great way to get your steps in! It is recommended to get 10,000 steps a day! If you have a spot on the bus, consider using the bus instead of driving to school.
