## 2. Principal's Report: Barb McVittie

  - Zen Den playground corner with a bench and other items for kids that want a quiet area.
     Items will need to be anchored down and cannot be moved. This will be something we grow over the next few years.

  - O Stand and stairs at the end of the volleyball nets for the reps.
    - Barb will cost everything out.

- Lego Drive part of what we'd like to do for community outreach next year for the robotics team is mentoring and teaching. Starting with building lego before robotics. This would be led by the students.
- Robotics there is non-competitive aspect from January June. Then the competition information is released in May. The competitive mission goes from September to December. There is a functional part, a challenge. Subway has been very well received by the kids.
