Class Re-Organization

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board reviews its student enrolment numbers in each school at this time of year. The enrolment numbers are compared to the projected enrolment numbers determined at the end of the previous school year, which initiates the staffing process.

As we look to meet the provincial class size requirements and finalize the enrolment numbers for this school year, it's typical for student enrolment to fluctuate.

There is a need to make some adjustments to our school classroom organizations based on our confirmed enrolment. Specifically, at our school on Monday September 30th:

- Mr. Perry's class will change from a Gr. 3/4 class to a Grade 2/3 class. The 5 Grade 4 students from Mr. Perry's class will be moving to Mrs. Goehner's Grade 4/5 class.
- 4 Grade 2 students from Mrs. McNabb's class will move to Mr. Perry's class.
- Mr. Levantis' class will change from a Grade 5 class to a Grade 5/6 class. 6 Grade 6 students from Mr. Lewis' class will be moving to Mr. Levantis' class.

EQAO Results

This month, parents and guardians of Grade 4 and Grade 7 students will receive their child's Individual Student Report (ISR). This report contains their child's results from the Assessments of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Primary and Junior Divisions, administered in spring 2019. These results did not impact students' report cards last year.

EQAO results offer an independent snapshot that shows whether students are meeting literacy and math expectations from *The Ontario Curriculum*. In receiving the ISR, there is an opportunity for parents and guardians to have discussions about their child's achievement within their family or with a teacher (e.g., parent/guardian-teacher interview).

EQAO data should be considered alongside other information—such as in-class assessment results, report-card grades and teacher observations—so parents and guardians can build a fuller understanding of their child's learning.

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Bus News & Information

We have **8 buses** coming in at the beginning and end of our school day. Please do not block the driveway or parking lot as it makes it difficult for the buses to maneuver and they are working under timelines.



We encourage your child to be taking the bus if eligible, to reduce traffic congestion and for safety.

We are NOT allowing students to go home with other students on a different bus. Please make other arrangements for students to visit another student's home.

The Parent's Portal tool on the HWSTS website (www.hamiltonschoolbus.ca) enables parents/guardians to create a secure online account where they can access transportation details for their student(s). They have further enhanced the portal to

allow account holders to choose to receive email notification when their bus is delayed more than 10 minutes.

Vacations and Extended Absences

The education of children is a right that we value and hold in high regard. When students are absent from school for extended periods of time, they miss large components of the curriculum taught and it becomes difficult for them to catch up as concepts that are taught build upon previous lessons.

Please note that we do not endorse or give consent to extended student absences for the purpose of family vacations. Every effort should be made to coordinate vacations with the school year calendar. We do however respect that you may choose to withdraw your child from Tapleytown School for the purposes of a family vacation. Please note that a program of study will not be provided by the school and not all areas of the curriculum will be assessed and reflected on the provincial report card. Your child will be removed from the school register after 15 consecutive days of absence. You will be required to re-register your child at the school office upon your return if they are absent for 15 or more days.

Religious and Creed-based Accommodations

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) is committed to working with students and families to create inclusive classroom and school environments. As we begin the new school year, we would like to remind families that schools are committed to work with you to provide appropriate and reasonable religious accommodations as per your requests.

The Ontario Human Rights Code provides the right for individuals to be free from discrimination. To protect this right, schools may make accommodations when issues or concerns with school practices relate to a student's religious or creed-based beliefs.

HWDSB is committed to working with families to determine appropriate and reasonable accommodations for students. Some examples of religious accommodations are: absence from class for a holiday observation, following a specific dress code, temporary absence from class to observe daily prayers, fasting or breaking a fast.

If you require religious accommodation for your child(ren), you are advised to contact your child's school at the beginning of the year. Call the teacher or the principal to discuss any religious accommodations your child may need. You can also provide specific dates and the type of accommodation required so that the school can plan in a timely manner.

Family requests for religious or creed-based accommodation should be made annually, as they are unique and considered on an individual, case-by-case basis. If you have arranged for religious accommodation for the last school year, you still need to make a new request for the new school year by contacting your child's teacher or principal. You may receive a letter or a phone call from the school to update your child's accommodation needs for the new school year.

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Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Verify the School Board Name.
- b) Select the School Name.
- c) Enter Your Child's First Name, Last Name and Date of Birth.
- d) Select "Continue".
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select "Continue".
- f) Your child has been added to your account.

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" and repeat the steps above. Eight children can be added to one parent account. If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

Payment Methods: Three Online Options

Option 1:



myWallet

An online wallet that can be loaded to hold funds and pay for items on School Cash Online.

myWallet eliminates the need to enter payment information multiple times. Simply sign into your account and select the myWallet tab. Click Add Funds to myWallet and use an eCheque to load funds into your account.

Once the funds are available, add all items into your shopping cart and select the myWallet payment method in your checkout options.
