

Tapleytown School Council Annual Report for the 2019/20 School Year

Dear Parents and School Community:

We would like to thank you, the parents, guardians and caregivers, so much for all your help and participation this year! And what a year that was!

Although the physical year was very short, the Tapleytown School Council had a very busy 2019/20 school year. The school council held 5 meetings, before the Covid shutdown, on September 18th, October 8th, November 12th, January 21st, and February 11th. Council worked on various issues during the year including gas lines and air conditioners for the portables, new sound system for the gym and graduation hoodies. Council also supported our wonderful Holiday luncheon, and frozen yogurt and popcorn days. These meetings are open to the public to encourage input from parents and other members of the school community. Minutes of meetings held and financial records are available for public inspection at the school office and on our school website. The purpose of the school council is to help improve student achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents. School councils are advisory organizations. Boards and principals are responsible for considering the recommendations made by each school council and for advising the council(s) of the actions taken in response to the recommendations.

Fund-raising activities were also cut short, but the activities we did conduct were successful, and the proceeds were used to fund projects in accordance with school board policies.

Our multi year initiative for the playground is now at: \$3229.60!
