We are asking for volunteers with Police Checks to assist with the program.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Growing Student Population at Viola Desmond: <ul> <li>We are getting 2 new portables, and opened another FDK class, (FDK 8) on the second floor.</li> <li>Re-organization puts classes at the proper cap sizes as recommended by the ministry.</li> <li>33 of 35 classes were affected by re-organization.</li> <li>45 students returned from remote learning and were added to classes.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	T. 	<ul> <li>Construction Fencing:</li> <li>This (temporary) fencing blocks off the reservoir. We are hoping for permanent fencing to be placed soon.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Incident in school, morning of Oct. 5<sup>th:</sup> <ul> <li>Police were called. Students were brought in early. Mrs. Morabito checked in with every class after the incident to be sure the children felt safe. A communication from the Board will be shared within the next few days.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>"Kiss and Ride" drop off zone:</li> <li>The drive leading up to the school has been zoned for Emergency Vehicles only so unfortunately it cannot be used as a Kiss and Ride drop off.</li> </ul>
