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Attention Parents: Dismissal Policy

Instructional time at Viscount occurs between 9:15-3:35. At times there will be classes outside on the back playground prior to dismissal for a variety of reasons (Phys. Ed, DPA).

Please note that for security and safety reasons, parents are not permitted to be on the back playground before 3:35 as the playground is considered an outside classroom.

Once the 3:35 bell rings for dismissal, we ask that parents only then enter the playground.

Thank you for your understanding so that we can continue to keep your children safe at school.

Parent Parking

Just a friendly reminder that when dropping off or picking up your child (entry and dismissal times) to please not block the bus loading zone or driveways, and please do not enter the parking lot. The parking lot is extremely busy at these times and we want to ensure the safety of all of our students. A new bus loading area is in the works. I will continue to update families as new information is provided.

Medical Information

Based on need, your child will soon be coming home with medical forms that need to be completed i.e. asthma, anaphylaxis, diabetes etc. This information will be posted in your

child's classroom, the office and in the staff room so that all staff is aware. Just a reminder about **Ryan's Law** – All students who require inhalers are always able to carry them with them.

• Bus students will line up in the gym in their respective bus line and attendance will be taken. They will then be dismissed from the gym and escorted by the teacher on duty to their bus.

• Any student being picked up will be dismissed through the back playground.

Please make the office and daycare aware of changes in afterschool/dismissal plans.

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Secure School Information

During this term, Cootes School is required to conduct at least 3 Fire Drills, 1 Lockdown Drill and 1 Evacuation Drill so that students are prepared in the event of a real emergency.

Please do not be alarmed if your child tells you that the alarm went off at school. This is all part of our Emergency Plan of Action.

Visitors Please Report to the Office

All visitors must first check in at the office. If you need to see or pick up your child, Mrs. Hylton or Mrs. Mills will page the classroom and have the student meet you at the office. If you are dropping something off, please label the item and leave it with our office staff to avoid disruptions in the classrooms.

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Notifications to School of Medical Conditions

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board is committed to ensuring a safe, accepting, and healthy learning environment which supports student well-being. This environment empowers students with health/medical needs to reach their full potential for self-management of their condition(s), according to their Plan of Care which is intended to support prevalent and non-prevalent medical conditions.

Returning Students (currently in SK to grade 8):

A Plan of Care is a plan for students who have a prevalent medical condition such as **anaphylaxis**, **asthma**, **diabetes**, and **epilepsy**. A Plan of Care is developed with the principal and provides details about your child's condition and how to manage it, what to do in the case of an emergency, a prioritized list of emergency contacts, information about medication, possibly even information about your child's health care providers, and who the Plan of Care should be shared with. During the week of September 6th Plans of Care were sent home with students for parents to review. We ask that Plans of Care be reviewed and sent back to the school.

NEW students (currently JK to grade 8):

If you are a NEW family to Viscount Montgomery School or are returning from Remote School, we ask that you please connect with the school immediately to identify whether your child has a prevalent medical condition such as **Anaphylaxis**, **Asthma**, **Diabetes** and **Epilepsy**. Families are to notify the school as soon as possible. School staff will then connect with individual families to provide specific forms to support the medical condition.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation in ensuring student safety!

Water Bottles

Water bottles will be provided to all students during the week of September 12th, as a welcome back gift from the staff of Viscount Montgomery. All water bottles will be the same so it is important that students labell their bottles with their first and last name.
