1. **Rotary Club of Waterdown Bursary ([link to application](#))** (*Cliff Lillicrop Bursary*) ~\$1000.00
The Rotary Bursary is presented annually by the Rotary Club of Waterdown to a graduating student going on to college or university.
Criteria:
 - a) scholarship
 - b) community service
 - c) financial need

2. **Rotary Club Literacy Award ([link to last year's application](#))** (*pending confirmation*) ~\$500.00
The Rotary Club of Flamborough AM presents the Literacy Award to a resident of Flamborough who will be starting an apprenticeship or attending college/university in the fall.
Criteria:
 - a) a passion for literature
 - b) a good citizen within his/her school and community
 - c) be attending a Community College in a "Technical field" or going on to an Apprenticeship in the work place or attending University in the Math or Sciences
