Each year, the Rotary Club of Waterdown presents several \$1,000 bursaries to students graduating from Waterdown District High School and pursuing post-secondary education.

Cliff Lillicrop was an active member of our Club whose 3 children all graduated from WDHS and we are pleased to remember him by giving his name to these bursaries.

The following criteria are considered for the awarding of the bursary funds:

- 1. Volunteer/community service activities, if any
- 2. Leadership experience, if any
- 3. Work experience, if any
- 4. Post-secondary education plans
- 5. Financial need (summary of existing funding and expected shortfall)

N.B. Students pursuing post-secondary education on a part-time basis are normally not eligible for consideration. Recipients must be accepted by a college or university and begin attending in September of 2021.

Applications must be submitted to WDHS by May 25, 2021.
