

## Grades 10 <br> Grade 11

- Must choose $\underline{8}$ courses per year.
- Each course must be in the appropriate pathway:

Applied $\rightarrow$ College, Academic $\rightarrow$ University

- All students must choose 1 Alternate Elective (only used in case a course is cancelled.)
- Check prerequisites in the course flowcharts if you're unable to choose a desired course.
- Keep in mind course requirements for future college/university/apprenticeship programs. Research NOW!


## Grades $11 \longrightarrow$ Grade 12

- Must choose $\underline{6-8}$ courses to ensure graduation and post-secondary requirements are met
- All students must choose 1 Alternate Elective (only used in case a course is cancelled.)
- If 6 courses are selected then choose both: STUDY1 (SEM1) \& STUDY2 (SEM2)
- If 7 courses are selected then choose: STUDYH (SEM1 or SEM2)
- Universities require 6 Grade 12 M or U courses (COOP does not count)
- Research on-line the College or University of your choice for program admission requirements
