- If 7 courses are selected then choose: **STUDYH (SEM1 or SEM2)**
- Universities require **6 Grade 12 M or U courses (COOP does not count)**







**Biology, Grade 11, University** 9, 10, 11, 12 1 Add

This course furthers students' understanding of the processes that occur in biological systems. Students will study theory and conduct investigations in the areas of biodiversity; evolution; genetic processes; the structure and function of animals; and the anatomy, growth, and function of plants. The course focuses on the theoretical aspects of the topics under study, and helps students refine skills related to scientific investigation.


