4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)*
3 credits in mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
2 credits in science
1 credit in Canadian history
1 credit in Canadian geography
1 credit in the arts
1 credit in health and physical education
1 credit in French as a second language
0.5 credit in career studies
0.5 credit in civics

## PLUS ONE CREDIT FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

Group 1: One additional credit in English, or French as a second language,** or a Native language, or a classical or an international language, or social sciences and the humanities, or Canadian and world studies, or guidance and career education, or cooperative education***
Group 2: One additional credit in health and physical education, or the arts, or business studies, or French as a second language,** or cooperative education***
Group 3: One additional credit in science (Grade 11 or 12), or technological education (Grades $9-12$ ), or French as a second language,** or computer studies, or cooperative education***

In addition to the compulsory credits, students must complete $\mathbf{1 2}$ optional credits $\boldsymbol{t}$, $\mathbf{4 0}$ hours of community involvement, and the provincial literacy requirement.
*A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) or English literacy development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned for a Grade 12 compulsory English course.
$* *$ In groups $1,2, \& 3$, a maximum of 2 credits in French as a second language can count as compulsory credits, one from group $1 \&$ one from either group 2 or group 3. ***A maximum of 2 credits in cooperative education can count as compulsory credits.
†The 12 optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved dual credit courses.
