Commencement Ceremony Wednesday, June 26th, 2024 3pm First Ontario Concert Hall


- Celebration is for all students (and guests) in the Class of 2024, regardless of graduation status

- Last day to drop a course and not have it show on your transcript if you are eligible to do so.

- May 1: deadline to accept an offer to an Ontario College program
- You can still apply to college. Check <u>www.ontariocolleges.ca</u> for open programs
- Programs can be open for both Sept 2024 & Jan 2025

- Offers will continue to be made for the remainder of the semester and can be made as late as May 31st
- June 3rd: deadline to accept an offer of admission to an Ontario University program


Once you find an open program of interest, add it to your 101 application.

- You will be completing or have completed the OSSD (or equivalent), including six 4U/M courses, by August 2023.
- You must have an average of at least 60%, although higher averages are usually required.
