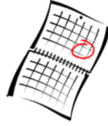

At the September 16 Grade 12 Assembly, your Guidance counsellors introduced many resources that you can access as you explore post-secondary research this year. Here is a summary of these resources

Ontario Universities Info	Your one-stop resource to learn about program offerings and admission requirements for universities in Ontario.
OUAC	The Ontario Universities Application Centre is the platform students use to apply to university. Applications are now open. Westdale Guidance will conduct an information session in October.
Ontariocolleges.ca	Research and application platform for Ontario College programs. Westdale Guidance will conduct an information session later this fall
Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program	Information for how to get started with an apprenticeship.
Skilled Trades Ontario	Information about skilled trades in Ontario and how to begin an apprenticeship.
Employment Hamilton	Resource for local employment search
OSAP	The Ontario Student Assistance Program can help fund your post-secondary education. You can access the Aid Estimator now. Do not apply until you have accepted a post-secondary offer.
Scholarship Report	This should be your first stop for researching scholarship information. The Scholarship Report requires a password—the report and the password can be found on The Hub in Westdale Guidance.
Ontario Learn and Stay Grant	This program has been available the past two years to support students with covering tuition and other educational costs of post-secondary programs in health human resources such as nursing, paramedic, and medical laboratory technician.
