

2025 Final Assessment and Evaluation Days

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to come for all 4 assessment days?

Yes. Please connect with your teacher to see what you will be asked to do on that day so you can prepare!



What time do I have to come to school on assessment/evaluation days?

Assessments and evaluations start at 9:00am – this is LATER than regular class time!. It is best to arrive around 8:45 am if you can. If you arrive early, you will be directed to wait in the cafeteria (the library will be closed).

What if I take a school bus to come to school?

School busses will run on their regular schedule. If you arrive early, you will be directed to wait in the cafeteria. The library will be closed.



What if I arrive to school late?

Try your best NOT to arrive late on these days. It might impact how much time you have for your assessment. Attendance will be taken and you will receive a phone call home to remind you to come to school for this important day.

How long do I stay at school on an assessment and evaluation day?

You must stay in your classroom from 9:00am–10:15am (75 minutes). Your teacher will dismiss you. Some classes may stay longer depending on your assessment/evaluation.

What do I do / where do I go after my assessment/evaluation?

Once your teacher dismisses you, you can go home (and prepare for your next assessment and evaluation if needed!). If you are waiting for the bus or a ride, you are NOT allowed in the hallways – some students will still be completing their work! You will wait in the cafeteria until your ride arrives. The library will be closed



What if I have more questions or am nervous about assessment and evaluation days?

That's okay! You should talk to and ask questions of your classroom teacher. You can also connect with your guidance counsellor or learning resource teacher.
