- hosting a lunch session tomorrow to walk students through the OUAC application

Principal's Report

- Superintendent Lee visiting the school tomorrow
- Biggest pain points are currently facilities related elevator needing repair and accommodating some classes on the first floor to support students with accessibility needs; today's partial power outage due to main breaker issues
- Brian acknowledges that bathrooms are still an area of concern for students; admin continuing to monitor those spaces; Van brought up a concern that water is 'scalding hot' in one of the single occupancy bathrooms
- Enrollment steady at about 1600 students
- Community newsletter coming out tomorrow
- Completed 4 x Grade assemblies for students in early September

- More buses this year that adds additional traffic in the parking lot; encouraging families to pick up their student after school on a side street
