Do I have to write the test?

- Yes, it is a requirement for your Ontario
 Secondary School Diploma.
- You will receive an Individual Student Report indicating whether or not you passed the test.

Who is eligible?

- If you started Grade 9 in 2016-2017
- If you have already been eligible and have not passed the test in earlier attempts

What happens if I'm not successful?

 You will be able to write the test in the next school year

or

 You may take the Grade 12 Literacy Course (you must have written the test at least once to be eligible)

Where?

- Learning Commons
- Several classrooms
- Check the list posted outside of the main office to determine where you will be writing

Punctuality and Absenteeism

- If you are absent you will have to write the test next year.
- If you are late, you will not be given any extra time and you will not have the instructions repeated. This will reduce your chances of passing.

What do I need to bring?

- HB pencil, blue or black pens
- no gym bags, backpacks, lunch bags, cell phones, iPods, iPads, or any other electronic devices

What if I finish early?

- Review your work.
- Bring a book.

What does the test involve?

- two booklets (Question Booklet 1 with an Answer Booklet 1, and Question Booklet 2 with an Answer Booklet 2)
- each booklet contains a reading and writing component

Reading Selections

- 1. Informational Text
- Paragraph or news report
- 2. Narrative
- Dialogue or real-life narrative
- 3. Graphic Selection

Types of Questions:

- 1. Multiple Choice
- choose the best or most correct answer
- use process of elimination if you can't find the answer easily
- circle only one option
- if you wish to change answers, put an X through first choice and circle your final choice
- 2. Open Response
- lined space suggests an appropriate length for answer

Writing Tasks

- 1) Summary (short)
- include the main idea of the original selection and at least two supporting details
- NOTE: This will be under the reading section of the OSSLT

- 2) Opinion Piece
- express an opinion on the topic provided
- develop your main idea with supporting details (proof, examples, etc.)
- minimum of three paragraphs

Writing Tasks

- 3) News Report
- based on a headline and picture
- make up facts
- use the "5 Ws and H"

- 4) <u>Multiple Choice</u><u>Questions</u>
- developing a main idea with supporting details
- organization of ideas
- language conventions

Writing Tips

- Use the lined space provided as a guide as to how long your answer should be.
- The audience is always an adult tone and language should reflect this.
- Be sure to follow instructions for each task since each task is different and stay on topic.

Writing Tips

- Write in complete sentences.
- Watch your time carefully.
- Write clearly and legibly. Handwriting that cannot be read cannot be marked.
- Do not write offensive material. Your work may not be marked.
