

## Westmount JUSTICE, Community Safety and Emergency Services SHSM

The SHSM- Justices, Community Safety and Emergency Services enables students to build a foundation of career-focused knowledge and skills before graduating and entering apprenticeship training, college, university or the workplace. The SHSM program is ideal for students interested in the field of law (lawyer, law clerk, politician, etc) criminalistics, forensic science, emergency services/first responders (police, fire, ambulance, security) military, border services agency, social justice (social worker, counsellor/therapist, addiction worker, etc), disaster relief services, health and safety or another justice, community safety and emergency services related careers.

### **Course Planning**

**Grade 9:** Students are encouraged to take Healthy Active living (PPL1O); Information Communication Technology in Business (BTT1O)

**Grade 10:** Students are encouraged to take Careers Studies (GLC2O3), Civics (CHV2O3) Healthy Active Living (PPL2O, PAQ2O); Information and Communication Technology (ICS2O) or Computer Technology (TEJ2O)

## Certifications

Students must complete at least six certifications including three required ones.

Certification	Required/Elective	Description

<input type="checkbox"/> First Aid	Required	Students will satisfy the requirements to be First Aid Certified.
<input type="checkbox"/> CPR	Required	Students will satisfy the requirement to be certified to perform CPR.
<input type="checkbox"/> Customer Service	Required	Students will develop skills to help them interact more effectively with customers and employees.

<p>Other Certifications to be determined but could include: self-defense, leadership skills, group dynamics, advanced training, techniques (ie. climbing), concussion awareness, confined space awareness, defensive driving, emergency response techniques, emergency response tools, (ie. fire hose), fire safety, and fire extinguisher use, fall protection, ethical considerations, incident management, ladder safety training, working at heights, life-saving bronze courses, mental health first aid, stress management or critical incident stress management training, legal/administrative procedures (handling subpoenas), Non-violent crisis intervention, PREP test mentoring, others, TBA</p>
