Parent Access to School	the building within 15 minutes of dismissal. Access to the school will be limited for caregivers and visitors. Contact the main office at 905-385-5395 ext. 0 before coming to the school to speak with a staff member. Please note that students will not have access to school phones to arrange pick ups as per Public Health protocols.
Parent Communication with School	Please communicate with teachers and the principal/vice-principal through phone and/or email. Contact the school at 905-385-5395 to speak with a teacher, principal or vice principal.
Elevator Use	Elevator use will be restricted to essential use. Contact the main office at 905-385-5395 to request access for your student.
Ill or Injured Students	Please do not sent ill or symptomatic students to school. Students who become Ill or injured students at school will wait in a separate supervised location. The school office will contact parents immediately to come to the school for pick up.
Student Lockers and Changerooms	Students will not be able to access lockers until further notice. Bring only the materials and personal belongings you need. Changerooms will also not be accessible. Students should be dressed appropriately for any health or physical education classes prior to coming to school.
Student Cohort Communication	Students and families can find their assigned cohort on the Parent Portal at the beginning of each rotation. Please note that cohorts may change for each face to face rotation to align with Public Health parameters to ensure cohort groupings of no larger than 17 students.
Staggered Entry in September	September 10 th and 11 th – There may be individualized visits for students needing additional transition support. Staff will contact families identified needing such supports to arrange times. In person classes: September 14 – Grade 9 and 10 cohort A face to face and remote learning; Grade 11 and 12 remote learning. September 15 - Grade 9 and 10 cohort B face to face and remote learning; Grade 11 and 12 remote learning. September 16 – All students Cohort A September 17 – All students Cohort B September 18—All Students Cohort A Remote learning: September 10 and 11– Begins for all students as welcome and orientation.
Device Deployment	Grade 9 students requiring ipads will be issued devices on September 14 th and 15 th during their period 1 face to face rotation. New students in Grades 10-12 will be issued an

	ipad in the following weeks if needed. If an ipad was issued between March and June of last year, students are asked to return those devices to be exchanged for an updated TLE ipad.
Student Lunch Routines	Students may bring a bag lunch and stay for lunch in their assigned location OR Students may leave the school property to have lunch offsite for the full 95 minutes, then return for the afternoon Study Hall. Cafeteria services and access to microwaves will be suspended at this time.
Study Hall	Parents/Caregivers are asked to indicate in the Parent Portal if their student is staying for study hall for the afternoon remote learning classes. Students who stay will be assigned to one location and seat for the afternoon.
Washroom Use	Students will use washrooms closest to their assigned location. Exceptions may be made by school staff.
