

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EQAO

Each year in May our Gr. 6 students write the EQAO assessment with other students across the province. The results of this assessment along with other data, are used to determine the learning goals of students in the school as outlined in the School Annual Plan.

The results for our Gr. 6 students in 2022/2023 that are performing at benchmark or above are as follows: Reading 69.6%, Writing 80.4% and Mathematics 20.1%. A focus of our School Annual Plan will be on Reading and Mathematics to develop the skills needed in our students in these areas.
