From the Principal's Desk...

Lates – I have noticed an increasing number of students being late for school, some on a daily basis. Our school day begins at 8:50 am and all students need to be on time to enter the school with their class. It is extremely disruptive to the learning of all and to the running of the school when students are late. Please plan appropriately to have children here on time and ready to learn.

Early Pick-up – if you must pick up your child early for any reason please enter this intent into the safe arrival program. All children who are to be dismissed early will need to be picked up at the office. Please limit early pick ups to emergencies only as the office is a very busy place and it is again disruptive to the classroom, and the school, to continually buzz in and locate students for pick up.

Trips, Safety and Behaviour Expectations

We have some great trips and school activities planned for June and they are all great experiences for students. However, safety is always at the forefront of planning and if we feel that a child's inappropriate behaviour will cause a significant safety concern they may not be allowed to participate unless a parent also attends. All board policies, board and school Code of Conduct, Equity policy, Safe Schools, etc. are in effect both in school and during any authorized school excursions. The principal is responsible for the safety of ALL members of the school community and appropriate consequences will be forthcoming for any violations of the above policies (all policies are available on the HWDSB website). We do use a progressive discipline approach when dealing with any issues but inappropriate behaviour that is a significant safety concern can and will lead to loss of privileges and suspension. Also, violation of the Inappropriate use of Electronic Devices policy can and will lead to loss of access to devices for any purposes.

Farewell and welcome - We will be saying goodbye to Mr. Lees who has retired after 31 years of teaching. Mr. Lees made an impact in many ways during his time here at Westview and he will be missed. Thank you to Ms. Moore for filling into for Mr. Lees until the end of the year. I am also pleased to announce that Ms. Mousseau will be on our staff full time next year as the Grade 6 Math/Science/PEH teacher.

Parent Council - A sincere thank you to our parent council members led by Mrs. Kristina Collier as chair. We greatly appreciate the participation of all and your ongoing support for our Westview staff and students.

Next Year - please find below the school organization for next year. We will be having 14 classes next year. As indicated in last months newsletter we appreciate your trust in our professional judgment in balancing all the considerations that come into play when creating classes. The final decision for class placements is the responsibility of the principal. If you have further information regarding your child's learning needs that we should consider, please make sure you have discussed the specifics with your child's teacher. We will not entertain requests for specific teachers, split grades vs. straight, or groupings of students. A reminder that the board has directed that class placements will not be shared with parent/guardians until the end of August via the Parent Portal.
