

Westwood School Council Annual Report for the 2018-2019 School Year

Dear Parents and School Community:

The Westwood School Council had a productive and successful year. The school council held 4 meetings this year. These meetings were open to the public to encourage input from parents and other members of the school community. School Council also worked on various initiatives during the year including fundraising, Wellness Night, and family Nights (movie nights and Bingo night).

The purpose of the school council is to help improve student achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents. School councils are advisory organizations. A school council's primary means of achieving its purpose is by making recommendations to the principal of the school and the school board. Boards and principals are responsible for considering the recommendations made by each school council and for advising the council(s) of the actions taken in response to the recommendations. - Organized and facilitated the holiday fundraiser,
