School Messenger

Reporting your student's absence:

If your student is going to be absent, please be sure to use the SafeArrival system – there are three options:

1. Use the SafeArrival website: go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance, then Report an Absence.

2. Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store (or from links go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance, then Report an Absence.

3. Call toll-free 1-844-506-4350 to report an absence using the automated phone system. Using this method does not require setting up an account. These options are available 24 hours/day, seven days a week. You can report a future absence any time

We encourage you to sign up as we will be using this service to send information to families via voice messages and email from time to time.






Sub Day

What Is A Concussion:

Any blow to the head, face or neck, OR a blow to the body which causes a sudden jarring of the head may cause a concussion (e.g., a ball to the head, colliding with another person).

Some Signs And Symptoms Of A Concussion:

A child does not need to lose consciousness or be knocked out

- Headache
- Dizziness
- Confusion
- Sleepiness
- Mood changes
- Stomach ache, nausea, vomiting

What To Do If Suspect A Concussion:

Stop the activity

Seek assessment from a health care provider
