

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SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION FUNDING

In 2014 the Ministry of Education introduced the **School Board Efficiencies and Modernization Strategy** to provide incentives and supports for school boards to make more efficient use of school space.

School boards engaged in accommodation reviews and submitted business cases for school consolidation.

The Ministry allocated \$750 million over a four-year period to support school facility improvement through school consolidation.



LSC ACCOMMODATION REVIEW

RECOMMENDED OPTION

Close and rebuild new schools at the following sites:

- Collegiate Avenue
- Eastdale
- Memorial (SC)

Close the following schools:

- Green Acres (students directed to new school at Collegiate Ave. site)
- RL Hyslop (students directed to new school at Collegiate Ave. site)
- Mountain View (students directed to new school at Eastdale or Memorial sites)




LSC ACCOMMODATION REVIEW

POSSIBILITY OF NO/PARTIAL FUNDING

- The Ministry of Education will indicate which schools are to be rebuilt based on their review of the business case submitted
- If one or two schools are funded for Lower Stoney Creek, additional public meetings may be required to discuss schedules, boundaries & transitions
- HWDSB would reapply to fund the remaining school(s)

LSC ACCOMMODATION REVIEW

On June 6, 2016, the Board of Trustees approved the closure of Collegiate Avenue, Eastdale, Green Acres, Memorial (SC), Mountain View and R.L. Hyslop pending Ministry of Education funding for three new JK-8 elementary schools on the Collegiate, Eastdale and Memorial (SC) sites and that boundaries between the three new schools be modified.





APPROVAL – EASTDALE SITE


On October 28, 2016 the Ministry of Education announced funding for building of a **new JK-8 elementary school for 564 students to be built on the existing Eastdale site**.

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Collegiate Ave. (2) students move to the new school at Eastdale site when construction is complete.

Collegiate Ave. (6) students move to holding school (Green Acres/RL Hyslop) during construction.

Green Acres & RL Hyslop (6, 7, 8) students move to school at Collegiate site when construction is complete.



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TRANSITION PLANNING

Transition Committees comprised of parents, staff and students will be established for the 2018-19 school year to collaboratively plan for a smooth transition of students to their new location.

Transition Committee 1

Collegiate Ave. (2) to the new school at Eastdale

Transition Committee 2

Collegiate Ave. (6) to a holding site at Green Acres/RL Hyslop



APPROVAL – COLLEGIATE AVE.

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for an addition to Collegiate Elementary School to accommodate 213 students.

HWDSB BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION

On December 18, 2017 the Board of Trustees approved a motion for staff to engage with the Ministry of Education to consider holding the \$6 million provided for the Collegiate Ave. addition for the purpose of resubmitting the business case for building a new school.

This process will take place throughout the month of January.

An update will be provided to communities in February.

HWDSB BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION

If written permission from the Ministry regarding this proposal is not obtained by January 31, 2018, the original motion (below) will move forward.

That the Board proceed with the project as funded by the Ministry: a 213 pupil place addition to the existing Collegiate Elementary School to support the consolidation of Green Acres Public School and R.L. Hyslop Public Schools,

- a) with a commitment to a phased design approach and financial monitoring updates to the Finance and Facilities Committee to ensure the project is feasible, based on scope and budget and;
- b) with a commitment to a public information process on the proposed design with the first meeting to be held by December 22, 2017.







- Staff room and office
