


#### **ACCOMMODATION REVIEW RESOLUTION**

On June 6, 2016, Trustees approved the following with respect to the Lower Stoney Creek accommodation review:

- 1. That Collegiate Avenue, Eastdale, Green Acres, Memorial (SC), Mountain View and R.L. Hyslop be closed
- pending Ministry of Education funding for three new JK-8 elementary schools on the Collegiate, Eastdale and Memorial (SC) sites

### MINISTRY FUNDING APPROVALS

On October 28, 2016 the Ministry of Education announced funding for building of a new JK-8 elementary school for 564 students to be built on the existing Eastdale site.

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for a **new JK-8 elementary school for 495 students to be built on the existing Memorial SC site**.

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for an addition to Collegiate Elementary School to accommodate 213 students.




#### **NEW SCHOOL ON EASTDALE SITE**




### New Elementary School on Eastdale Site

#### **Full Day Kindergarten:**


- 5 Kindergarten Rooms

#### New Elementary School Construction Timelines



- Project is currently in Municipal Approvals Phase
- Projected completion for 2019/2020 school year (12 18 months).

### **RELOCATION TO MOUNTAIN VIEW**

Eastdale students will be accommodated at Mountain View school commencing September 2018.

#### Rationale:

- Proximity Relocating to Mountain View keeps Eastdale students within own community
- Eastdale community stays together through relocation and transition
- Eastdale & Mountain View can form new school community together prior to moving to new school



### **MOUNTAIN VIEW HOLDING SITE**

- Mountain View will be configured to service additional portable classrooms to accommodate incoming students
- Universal barrier free washroom
- Accessible Main Entrance with new concrete sidewalk from parking area
- New ramp to ensure accessibility to playground
- Currently reviewing feasibility to expand parking lot





### **BUS TRANPORTATION**

Bussing will be available to eligible students as per HWDSB Transportation Policy

- Students in kindergarten who reside more than 1 Km from Mountain View will be eligible for transportation
- Students in grades 1 to 8 who reside more than 1.6 Km from Mountain View will be eligible for transportation



#### STUDENT SAFETY AND WALKABILITY

HWDSB will continue to collaborate with City of Hamilton staff to ensure crossing guards at key locations to ensure safe walking to and from school.





### TRANSITION PLANNING

If the Board of Trustees' decision is consolidation, closure or major program relocation, the following school year will be used to plan for and implement the Board's decision.

A separate advisory group (Transition Committee) will be established to address the transition for students and staff of the affected schools.

### TRANSITION COMMITTEE

- The Transition Committee provides advice to support a smooth and successful transition for all students, staff and families.
- Transition Committees are led by the Superintendent of Student Achievement in partnership with the school Principal and Vice-Principal.
- Transition Committees typically have a series of meetings prior to the commencement of the planned transition.



### TRANSITION COMMITTEE

Transition Committees provide advice on a variety of matters including:

- Artefacts and/or traditions to be incorporated into the new school
- School renaming based on Naming of Schools Policy # 2.3
- Activities to support students and families prior to actual move
- Opening/closing ceremonies



### TRANSITION COMMITTEE

Transition Committees are typically composed of the following representatives from <u>each</u> affected school:

- Principal & Vice-Principal
- 1 Student
- 1 Teacher, 1 Learning Resource Teacher & 1 Support Staff Member
- 1 School Council Member & 1 Home & School Association Member
- 1 Parent Representative
- 1 Community Partner
- 1 Special Education Advisory Council Member (SEAC)
- Area Trustee
