HWDSB TRANSITION COMMITTEE


Transition Committees provide advice on a variety of matters including:

ZONE 1

Students move to Mountain View following the closure of Eastdale School Students move to new school on Eastdale site when construction is completed

ZONE 2

Students move to new school on Eastdale site when construction is completed

ZONE 3

Students move to new school on Eastdale site when construction is completed

ZONE 4

Students remain at Mountain View and move to new school on Memorial SC site when construction is completed

ZONE 5

Students move to new school on Memorial SC site when construction is completed

ZONE 6


Students move to holding site (i.e. Green Acres/R.L. Hyslop) and return to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed

ZONE 7

Students move to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed

ZONE 8

Students move to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed



HWDSB NAMING OF SCHOOLS POLICY 2.3

The Naming of Schools process <u>shall</u> begin under the following circumstances:

 Closure of two or more schools and consolidation into a new build on an existing or new site (Appendix B – New School on Eastdale Site)

The Naming of Schools process <u>may</u> begin under the following circumstances, only if the affected schools would like to proceed and subsequent approval from the Board of Trustees. This is to be determined through discussion with the School Councils and Home & School Associations, where they may exist, of the affected schools:

 Closure of one or more schools and consolidation into an existing school (Appendix C)

HWDSB NAMING OF SCHOOLS - PROCEDURE

Closure of One or More Schools and Consolidation into an Existing School; or Replacement School Built on an Existing or New Site 2.1

- 1. The naming of the entire school or a part of the school will only begin after discussion with the affected School Councils. This is to determine whether the school community would like to proceed with renaming the school or a part of the school.
- 2. The Principal, in discussion with the Chair of School Council, will add this item as a discussion piece to a future School Council meeting and will provide sufficient notice to the school community about when the item will be discussed.
- 3. The Principal will inform their Superintendent of Student Achievement of the desire of the committee to proceed or not with either naming/renaming the school in whole or in part.
- 4. The Superintendent of Student Achievement will bring a report to the Board of Trustees, summarizing the discussion held at the School Council meetings, for a final decision to proceed or not.
