
# **Lower Stoney Creek School Consolidation Plan**

<u>Transition #3 2019-20</u> – Move to new school at Memorial (Mountain View, Memorial)

# **Staffing**

There is a process where the board works with employee groups for teacher and support workers' job placements.

- Will work towards maintaining unity
- Teachers may be able to follow pathway of student
- Staffing is too early to predict at this time.

## **Naming Schools Policy**

Distribution and review of Policy 2.3 and Procedure for Naming of School

- Will go through naming process for new school at Eastdale
- Eastdale to Mountain View MAY be renamed
  - school councils need to start a conversation around this referring to the Policy
  - School administration will lead this conversation and report back to SOSA

### Communication

Parents may not have an overall sense of what is happening. Besides letters and web postings, is there anything else board or schools can do for further communication?

- Newsletter, twitter, push notification to phones
- Direct parents to Construction Website via newsletters
- Pair Synervoice message with letter coming home; "check your child backpacks"
- Encourage staff to talk about the new school and show images; students will share their excitement with parents
- ESL teacher at Eastdale will reach out to parents and will ask if translations are needed
- Is social media the best way to reach out to parents?
- Currently looking at signage for outside the schools as a way of notifying the community

## **Events / Activities**

Both councils came together to talk about family and event planning transitions.

- Bit of framework has been developed.
- Finding ways to have joints classroom experience with grade to grade (i.e. skype)
- Goal is to have a monthly event
- Two events in May Meet and Greet for parents to parents
- June Meet and Greet for parents to staff

## **Open Discussion**

Equipment and furniture will be possibly stored.

- Movers may store things over the summer and move into portables when they are ready
- Board will work with teachers.
- Movers have totes that will be available for easy packing

### **Transportation**

- Will follow Transportation Policy; cannot predict at this time
- Most students will be within the walking area of new Eastdale
- Crossing guards will be put in place as needed by the City of Hamilton
- Luis Patricio, School Travel Planning Coordinator, can work with school councils when changes come into place

## **Before & After School Care**

Mountain View has before and after school program and Eastdale does not. Will this be carried over? Can Mountain View's program accommodate Eastdale kids?
