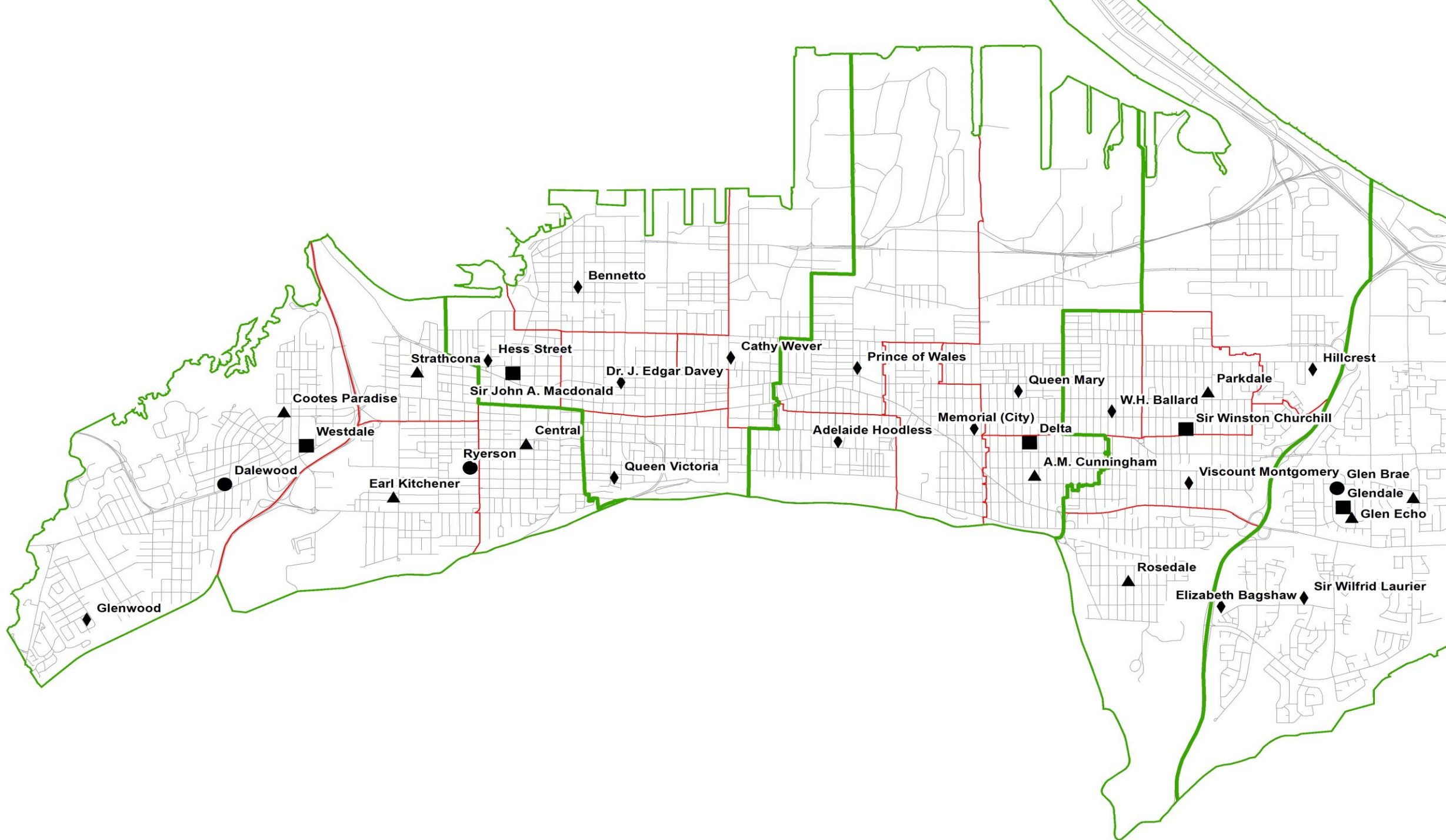

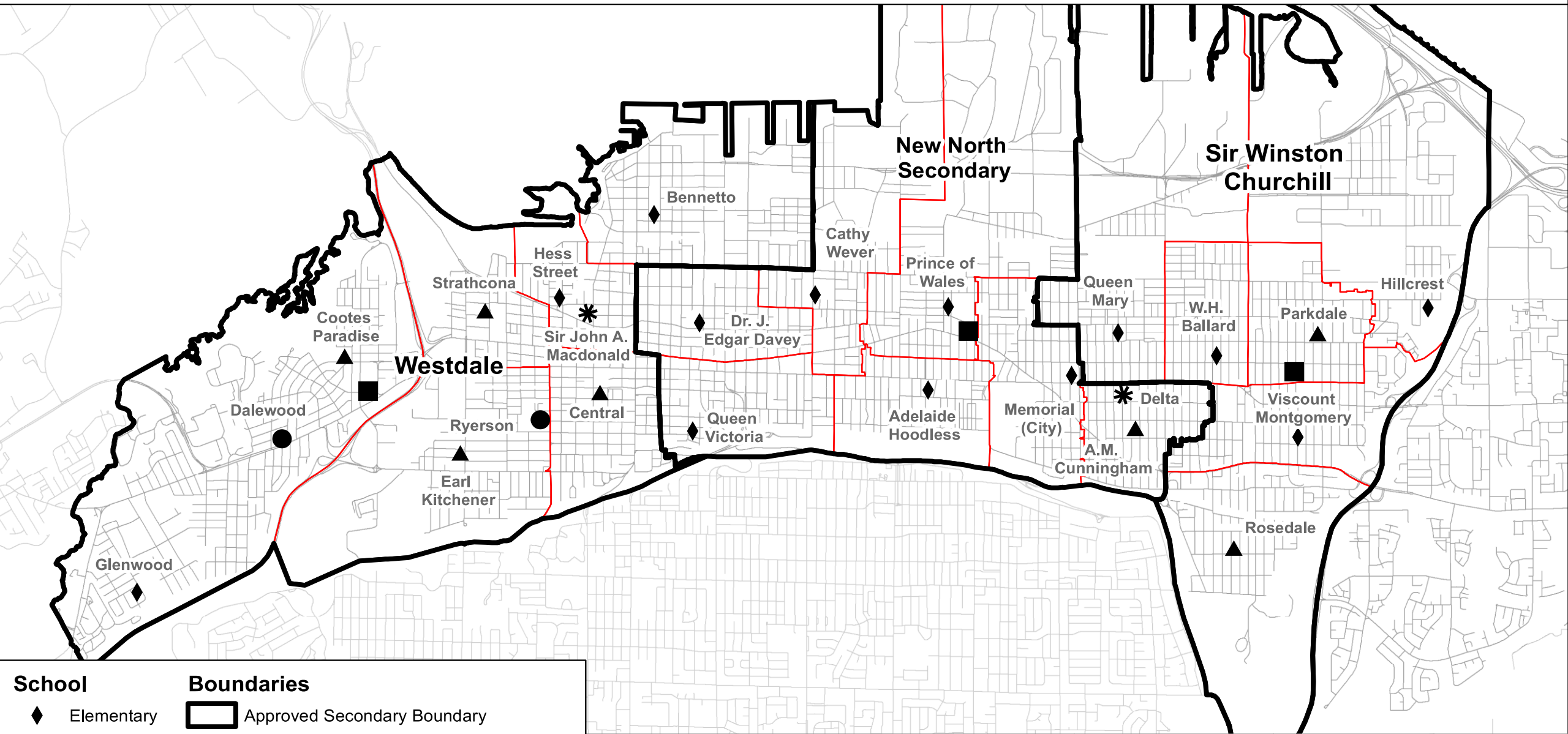

- Naming advisory committee
- Report to Board of Trustees for final decision

### Current Grade 8's:

- Current grade 8's at Hess St. and Bennetto may go to Westdale this year if they wish.
- Current grade 8's at Queen Mary may go to Sir Winston Churchill next year if they wish.

### Internal Transition:

- Inventory for Delta is complete.
- Inventory for SJAM will be done this summer.
- Facilities, finance, program and school staff will decide on which furniture and equipment will be used and which will be surplus.

- Construction is on schedule
- Double classroom will be changed to two classrooms
- Both Delta and SJAM have new school display boards.
